The Program:

The Family Preservation program provides intensive counselling to MCFD mandated clients with child protection concerns with the goal of reducing risk to children and where relationship abuse may have been identified.

The Job:

You will be responsible for co-facilitating the Agency's groups for men who are perpetrators of domestic abuse and who have made a commitment to their partners and/or to MCFD to address their behaviour. Groups are held in English and in Farsi.

The Candidate:

The ideal candidate will:

- Have significant experience working with abusive men.
- Have experience working with the criminal justice system and MCFD.
- Have significant understanding and awareness of gender-based violence.

The Qualifications

The successful candidate will have:

- a Masters degree in counselling psychology, social work or equivalent and current RCC, RSW, AAMFT or CCC registration as well as a minimum of 5 years of experience.
- Language proficiency in Farsi, Korean, Mandarin or Cantonese would be considered an asset as would experience working with First Nations People.
- Specialized training on gender based violence responses, and working with men who use violence would be considered an asset.
