The Agency:

Family Services of the North Shore is an accredited, not-for-profit, community based agency committed to making a deep and lasting impact on our community through counselling, support, education and volunteer programs.

The Programs:

Our EAP program provides EAP services under our contract with FSEAP Vancouver and others.

Our Individual, Couple and Family Counselling Program (ICF) provides clinical counselling services to members of the community who are dealing with a variety of clinical concerns such as anxiety, depression, traumatic stress, grief and loss, and a range of relationship issues. Services are offered to clients on a fee-for-service basis on a sliding scale.

The Job:

You will provide clinical counselling services primarily to clients in our EAP program. You may also see clients in our ICF program, often those who wish to continue with counselling once their EAP sessions are finished. Services will be offered primarily to adult individuals but also to couples and families. Clients in the EAP program present with concerns similar to those in the ICF program, but will also include work-related issues.

You will see clients primarily on Saturdays but also potentially at other times, schedules permitting.

This is a contract position providing services on an as-needed basis (up to 10 hours per week).

You will receive supervision from the Program Manager / Clinical Supervisor for the ICF / EAP program.

The Candidate:

You have a Master's degree in clinical counseling, social work, or a related field; current RCC, AAMFT, RSW, or CCC registration; and at least five years (2,500 clinical hours) of post-master's degree experience working with individuals, couples and families. You must be eligible for registration with our EAP provider.

In addition to strong clinical skills with a focus on assessment, you have excellent file documentation practices and experience completing EAP documentation. Experience providing a range of EAP services would be considered an asset as would language proficiency in a language in addition to English. You must also have the ability to work independently.
