# Criminal Record Checks Required Every 5 Years

To align with procedures in place at Family Services of the North Shore and now in Vancouver Coastal Health, criminal record checks must be renewed every 5 years. This policy is intended to ensure the safety of any children in our care. If your Crim Check was done in 2005 or earlier, you will need to request a new one through your local police detachment. For North Vancouver residents, there is no charge for volunteers, so over the coming week I will draft a letter of introduction for you to take with you. Be sure to bring two pieces of photo id. To continue volunteering, please provide me with your updated crim check (original please, not a copy) by December 31, 2010.

## LGH Parking Update

In mid-November, new parking rules will come into effect. The parking stamp used today will no longer be valid. For volunteers who wish to use the parkade, a hang tag will be available for a one-time charge of \$20. This will enable you to park on either of the two lower levels of the parkade at no charge while volunteering, as long as this special tag is displayed in your windshield.
