Counselling at Family Services of the North Shore

Individuals, couples, children, youth and families continue to receive exceptional clinical counselling services at Family Services of the North Shore.

Each year 1,104 people reach out to us for help with depression, anxiety, childhood abuse, relationship violence, parenting concerns, couples conflict, isolation, divorce, bullying and many other issues. The good news is that with support of an experienced counsellor, these individuals feel better, do better and thrive. Our outcome surveys confirm these exceptional results.

Child and Adolescent Sexual Abuse Counselling

As a result of therapy, 80% of our youngest clients have developed more confidence. understand that the sexual abuse was not their fault, know they are in charge of their bodies and are able to stand up for themselves. 82% of our clients have learned how to keep themselves safe from further abuse.

At the end of therapy, 82% of our clients understood more about how their past experiences influence their lives today. 91% experience less anxiety, use healthier ways to deal with their feelings and feel good about themselves.
